Withdrawals: Refund – only with medical certificate – a 10% deduction from the entry fee before the draw and no refund available after the draw.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to the first three placegetters in each event. The Perpetual Trophies will be retained by the Sydney Figure Skating Club and will be engraved with the winner's name and displayed at Canterbury Olympic Ice Rink.

Music: Music MUST be sent through via email to nswisa.music@gmail.com or music can be uploaded on the NSWISA website. MP3 PREFERRED. Files MUST be saved with competitors full name and division entered. Vocal music is permitted.

Registration: The official registration desk will be located at the main entrance. Competitors must check in 1 hour before the event.

Draws:

The opening draw for all events will be conducted on **Friday, May 29, 2015** and the Skating Order for each event will be published on **Monday, June 1, 2015**. Subsequent Skating Order for Novice, Junior & Senior events (Singles, Pairs & Dance) will be determined following the conclusion of the applicable event by reversing the results from the SP or SD for each event.

Judges:

Each State association of ISA, together with the NZ Ice Figure Skating Association Inc, ARE invited to nominate a Judge or Judges for any of the scheduled events, subject to their possessing the required qualifications for that level of judging. Photography:

An official photographer will be taking photos at the 2015 Hollins Trophy. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. For private photographers, please note that no flash photography is allowed in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters. All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registrations desk on the day of the event.

Video Recording: Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information/Registrations desk on the day of the event. Videoining can only be undertaken in the designated area and a written application is required. **NO VIDEOING OF PRACTICE SESSIONS IS ALLOWED.**
