REGISTRATION	All skaters (including Aussie Skate) are required to register their arrival inside the entrance to the Rink beginning 30 minutes prior to the start of the events each day. Officials please give your name at the ticket office and make your way to the Officials' area on the right hand side of the ice.
MUSIC	All competitors in divisions requiring their own music shall provide it on an audio quality CD. The CD must contain only ONE track, and must be marked with the: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Competitor's Name• Competition Division, e.g. 'Preliminary'• Program Identification, e.g. 'Freeskating Program'• Running time of music (NOT skating time)• Aussie Skate Levels Tiny Tots – Intermediate will have background music provided. PLEASE NOTE THAT <u>TWO COPIES</u> OF MUSIC SHOULD BE HANDED IN AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION
COACHES	<u>Only APSA accredited coaches</u> will be permitted at the barrier with skaters during warm-up and competition.
AWARDS	Will be made to the first three place getters in each event and all competitors will receive a certificate of participation.
RESULTS	Published at www.actisa.asn.au and the rink notice board.
ENTRY FEE TO RINK PER DAY	As determined by rink management. All entries are to be paid at front office. Chaperone passes will not be issued with entries.
PRACTICE TIMES	No official practice ice will be provided but normal figure skating sessions will be available for practice. Please contact the rink for details.
