Entry Process	<p>Online entry submitted via entrant’s State Association Online entry via the NSWISA website: >Forms>Competition>SFSC-Trophy Night.</p> <p>The relevant state association will ensure that all entrants are eligible to compete and that membership status is current, prior to submitting the entry registrations to the LOC. An excel spreadsheet must accompany the state’s entrant list, detailing the name, division and payment status of the entrant. PPC and music submission must be submitted with the entry or the entry remains incomplete.</p>
Conditions for Online Entry	<p>All Interstate competitors must notify their relevant state association of their entry submission prior to entering.</p> <p>All state associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the state association and an affiliated club. PHOTOGRAPHY

An official photographer will be taking photos at the event.

Photos will be available for viewing and purchase at the photographers table.

For private photographers, please note that no flash photography is permitted in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters. All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registrations desk to complete a permission to photograph form for **your child ONLY** on the day of the event. An accreditation lanyard will be provided and must be visible at all time whilst photographing your child. Without a visible accreditation lanyard you will be asked to leave the area and cease photography.

Photography can only be undertaken in the clearly marked designated area.
NO PHOTOGRAPHY WILL BE PERMITTED AT ANY TIME WITHOUT A PERMIT.

VIDEOGRAPHY

An official videographer will be videoing at the event. No lights during videoing permitted. Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information / Registration desk to complete a permission to video **your child ONLY** on the day of the event. An accreditation lanyard will be provided and must be visible at all time whilst videoing your child. Without a visible accreditation lanyard you will be asked to leave the area and cease videoing.

Videoing can only be undertaken in the clearly marked designated area.
