President

Desired skills: A successful President, will have a strong decision-making framework, based on a strong knowledge of the club rules, policies, vision and understanding of club operations, that allows confident decision making that are in the best interest of the club and its members.

- Purpose: To ensure that all business pertaining to the Club is in order and that the club operates within the rules established by the Bylaws/constitution, NSWISA and all other rules and laws pertaining to a non-profit organization..
- Shall preside at all meetings of the Executive and shall perform all other duties incident to the office of President. The president shall be available whenever possible to assist with club matters, attending all meetings that are called to order.
- Maintain a personal and professional behavior of cooperation, collaboration, respectfulness and most of all courteousness at all times.
- The president or vice president may be required to fulfill the roles of the SFSC/ NSWISA delegate and/or the rink SFSC Co-operative representative.
- Ensure executive reporting requirements are met.
- Championship events/Artistic/Aussie Skate/Developmental competitions require the volunteering support of all members of the committee.
- ***Must be an SFSC current financial member.***
- ***Must be an NSWISA volunteer member.***
- ***Must Provide a current WWCC number to the Membership Officer.***
- ***Upon appointment, must complete the Committee Member Agreement***
