



2026 SFSC MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS

(1 January – 31 December 2026)

By applying for financial membership to SFSC, you (or a parent/guardian on behalf of their child) agree:

1. To abide by the SFSC Constitution, SFSC Code of Conduct and all SFSC Policies as in force during 2026.
2. That **all** membership applications are subject to the approval of the SFSC Committee.
3. To ensure that you abide by the conditions of any rink that you are training and/or competing at so as not to bring yourself and/or SFSC into disrepute by your conduct.
4. To volunteer at any SFSC Competition, SFSC organised event for no less than 6 hours for the year, noting that:
 - 4.1 Parents/guardians of member skaters may volunteer on behalf of their child;
 - 4.2 All volunteers 18 years and over are required to hold a current Working With Children Check (WWCC); and
 - 4.3 If unable to volunteer at an SFSC competition or organised event, members may satisfy the volunteering requirement in other ways, such as donating goods and/or services to the Club.
5. To the publication of skating related photos and/or footage for promotional purposes.
6. If competing you must represent, or intend to represent, SFSC in at least one of the following disciplines:
 - 6.1 Singles
 - 6.2 Artistic
 - 6.3 Inclusive (special needs)
 - 6.4 As part of a Pairs Team
 - 6.5 As part of an Ice Dance Couple or as a Solo Ice Dancer; or
 - 6.6 As a skater in one of Majestic Ice Australia's (MIA) established SFSC Synchronised teams (subject to MIA's selection and approval process).



7. That only in exceptional circumstances will the SFSC Committee consider requests for SFSC Membership where the skater would otherwise not be able to satisfy the representation conditions set out in clause 6. A written request must be submitted to the committee care of the Secretary at sydneyfigureskatingclub@gmail.com, as part of the membership application process.
8. That the SFSC Committee reserves the right to refuse any membership application and does not have to provide reasons for its decisions.
